Progress on action plan, including safety actions, as of May 23, 2019

A. Improve patient, staff and public safety

- We have hired new clinical security liaison nurses who will specialize in therapeutic and relational security, helping keep staff, patients and physicians at the hospital safe.
- Our Code White (emergency incident) policy has been revised and is available to staff and physicians. A new, corresponding eLearning package and quiz has been developed and all FPH staff will be completing it.

B. Improve clinical-service delivery and patient centred care

- We are actively recruiting for a joint health care worker and instructor. This newly created position will involve being both a health care worker and taking a lead role in facilitating the Provincial Violence Prevention Program course at FPH.
- Patient needs assessment data continues to be collected and collated. This will be communicated to staff at the Town Hall.

C. Strengthen leadership, inter-disciplinary teamwork and professional development

- The first of a series of workshops to improve communication and collaboration among nurses, clinical leadership and physicians has taken place. These are collaborative discussions about the current state of the working relationships between these groups.
