Progress on action plan, including safety actions, as of April 16, 2019

A. Improve patient, staff and public safety

- Interviews for clinical security liaison nurses, who will provide leadership in therapeutic and relational security, are underway. We plan to make offers near the end of the month.
- We've approved new safety protocols on secure room entry and exits as well as post-incident debriefing.

B. Improve clinical-service delivery and patient centred care

- Data collection for our patient needs assessment, which will inform future staffing, is now complete.
- A new communication tool, a daily hospital census, is being completed and sent to all staff and physicians by the patient care supervisor. This will give all staff a more comprehensive sense of the hospital population, needs and potential concerns day by day.

C. Strengthen leadership, inter-disciplinary teamwork and professional development

- As part of ongoing staff training and development, 170 staff across all levels attended our collaborative therapeutic and relational security expo on April 8, 2019, and provided excellent feedback.
